13. Exhibitors must furnish their own water, food containers, and rabbit food.
14. All market rabbits will be released from the Fair on Saturday evening at 7:00 pm (the last night of the fair)

BREEDING RABBITS (Book 225)

Judging: Sunday, 9:00 a.m. / Showmanship follows after

Rules:

1. Breeding rabbits will be accepted from 6-9:00 p.m. on the day before the Fair starts OR between 8-9:00 a.m. on Sunday before the show (in a carry case). Breeding rabbit exhibitors must reserve pens by the second Friday in July if they choose to bring their breeding rabbits the day before the Fair starts. Rabbits brought the day before the Fair starts MUST be left on display at the Fair until 7:00 pm Saturday, the last day of the fair. Breeding rabbits brought in the day of the show will be released following the show.
2. An exhibitor may show only one entry per sub-class for each breed and may only show in 12 sub-classes.
3. If entering either sub-class 148 or sub-class 157 (other purebreds) the specific breed must be listed on the entry
4. Powder is considered an artificial coloring of rabbits and is not permitted.
