or 2 Purebreds & 2 Crossbreds**

Entry fee is \$10.00 per animal. A maximum of 4 market hogs may be shown; however, an exhibitor may only bring a maximum of two crossbreds. Entries close at 12:00 noon on Sunday, July 22, 2018

All swine being exhibited solely in the Open Class show will have to be removed from the fairgrounds by 8:00 a.m. July 24, 2018 This is not a terminal show. The exhibitor will be responsible for all barrows to be removed from the fairgrounds . All other Jr. Fair Rules will apply for the Sr. Fair Show.

Open class animals can be brought to the fairgrounds on July 20th starting at 8:00 P.M. until 8:00 A.M. July 21st or from Midnight til 9:00am on July 23rd. Barrows will be weighed immediately following the conclusion Jr. Fair weigh-in. There will be an additional weighin from 10:00A.M. to 11:00 A.M. for those exhibitors arriving after the Jr. Fair weighin.

Light and heavy barrows will be permitted to show, but will not be eligible for premiums.

Exhibitors must purchase an exhibitor ticket, youths under 18 years of age may exhibit on parent's ticket.
